Mentor has a Specific Recommendation by AHDB for both East/West and North regions in 2019/20 and is resistant to common strains of clubroot. It has a high gross output with good stem stiffness and good agronomic characteristics.

Mentor is recommended for growing on land infected with common strains of clubroot. It may, however, be infected by some strains and infections that have been reported in some fields.

- ✓ Mentor has good seed yield combined with high oil content to give good gross output.
- ✓ Mentor has good resistance to light leaf spot.
- ✓ Mentor has good stem stiffness and resistance to lodging and is of medium height.
